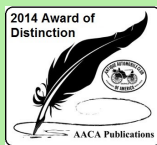
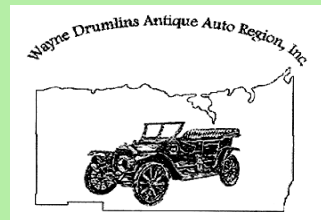

In between helping with membership renewals and answering questions from potential advertisers regarding our membership, it got me thinking... I wonder which states have the most AACA members? Do we have members in all 50 states? Besides the U.S., which countries have the most members? Where in the world are AACA members? So, I asked for current membership reports and started sorting and calculating and comparing numbers. Here's what I discovered:

Total Current AACA Memberships: 32,993*

AACA members can be found in all 50 states in the U.S., plus the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands. Did you know that we have over 200 memberships in Alaska? And almost 200 memberships in Puerto Rico!

The top 10 states where you can find the largest number of AACA memberships are:

1. PA	6122	6. NJ	1589
2. NY	2733	7. CA	1359
3. FL	2644	8. OH	1234
4. VA	1666	9. MD	1192
5. NC	1607	10. TX	1020

Regarding foreign memberships, our neighbor to the north wins by a landslide. The top 5 countries (other than the U.S.) with the most AACA memberships are:

1. Canada	462
2. Australia	38
3. Costa Rica	30
4. England	22
5. New Zealand	18

So, I guess the simple answer to my question is
that AACA members are EVERYWHERE

**As of 10-22-15. These numbers represent actual AACA membership records. AACA has several types of memberships including individual and joint. Because the majority of our memberships are joint, we feel comfortable stating that our total number of members is around 60,000.*

Northeast Rally Club

Rally Round the Erie Canal 2016

May 13-15, 2016

The Northeast Rally Club is proud to announce that their annual spring rally will take place in Fairport, NY. During the 2012 Great Race, this village on the Erie Canal was voted best lunch stop by drivers and navigators. Come see what Fairport has to offer and why it is "one of the best 100 places to live".

Dates of the spring rally are May 13-15, 2016. This includes a fun run Friday followed by competition Saturday and Sunday. The rally will consist of routes through the beautiful Finger Lakes region of New York State and will include a stop at Three Brothers Winery in Geneva, NY. Lunch Saturday will be hosted by Great Race Veterans John and Scott Hudson, in Baldwinsville, NY.

The field for this rally will be limited to 50 cars. A deposit of \$200 is required to hold your spot for the 2016 Rally Round the Erie Canal. This will be half of your \$400 rally weekend fee that is due by March 2016. This does not include hotel accommodations. The host hotel is the Hampton Inn and Suites in Victor NY. The rooms will have to be booked no later than 30 days prior to the event; otherwise we cannot guarantee a room at the Northeast Rally Club rates. The details on contacting the host hotel is included in your application for the event.

For this weekend rally old cars are encouraged but not required, you can run whatever you prefer. Your final daily score will be age factor adjusted for the year of your vehicle, the older the car the better the factored final score. There are three divisions: Pro, SOP, and Rookie. Pro's will use a timewise rally speedometer, SOP is "seat of the pants" where you will use the stock speedometer in your vehicle and Rookie class is for anyone that has not competed in a Northeast Rally Club event. 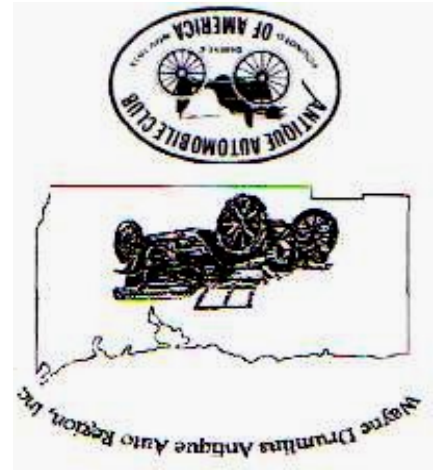
