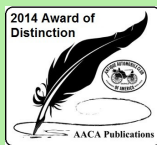
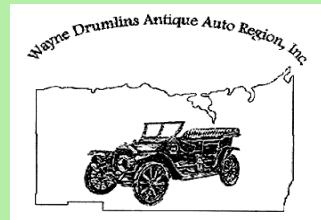

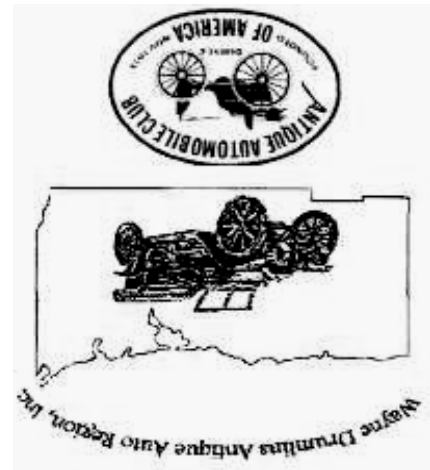
Trunk light, and Hub shell covers – full size hubcaps – a 1-year-only style for '52.
