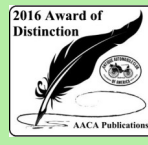
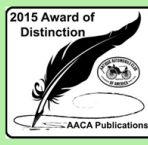
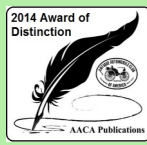

Ticket sales are on a first come, first served basis. The best recommendation is to have your tickets reserved **before** the first of June. Tickets need to be paid for at the time of ordering and can be ordered by contacting The Canandaigua Lady. Call (585) 396-7350 for public information and booking.

Following the cruise, we will meet for the Motometer tour at about 2:30pm at the Ontario County Historical society, 55 North Main Street, Canandaigua. There is off street parking behind the Museum.

After the Motometer tour, we plan on gathering for dinner at a local restaurant. The specific restaurant is yet to be determined and any suggestions from Club members is welcome. 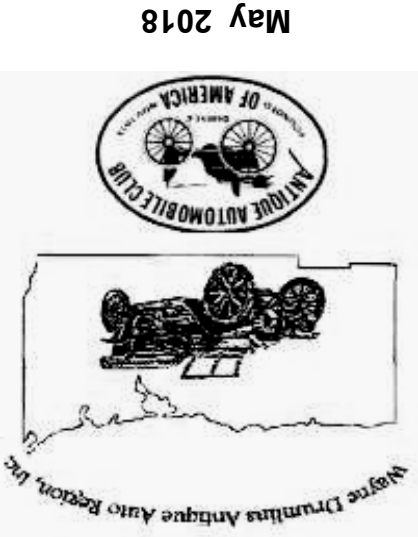
